## A Note from Mrs. Hess



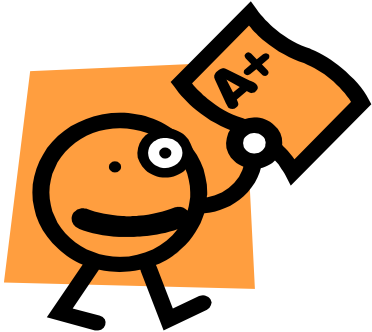
